

SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com.

The Admission for B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. Degree courses will be made purely on the basis of merit, subject to the reservation rules of the Government of Tamilnadu. The marks scored by the applicant eligible for admission are to be normalized as follows: Marks secured in Part III out of 400.

SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR M.A. / M.Sc. / M.Com.

The Admission for M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. degree course will be made purely on the basis of merit, subject to the reservation rules of the Government of Tamilnadu. The marks scored by the applicant in relevant major subject and allied subject will be taken into account for admission.

For SC / ST Candidates only one application form will be issued at free of cost on the production of attested xerox copy of his/her community certificate.

All applicants should submit along with the application a medical fitness certificate certified by a Government Doctor, not below the rank of a civil surgeon. Attested copy of Sports Participation Certificate must be enclosed with the application.

ADMISSION:

Application for admission to U.G., and P.G., classes should be sent to the Principal. Application forms can be had in person on payment of Rs. 48 / 58 each for UG/PG course from the office. Application fee once paid will not be refunded.

Registration fee of Rs. 2 /- is to be paid at the time of Registration of Application. The application form duly filled in should be submitted to the Principal in person. Duplicate application form duly filled in should be sent to The Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli - 627 012.

Incomplete application will be rejected.

Candidates provisionally selected for admission will have to report for interview along with the parents / guardians. Candidates reporting for interview shall bring with them the following certificates in originial along with two xerox copies (attested) for each.

- 2. Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied
- 3. Statement of Marks(+1 and +2)
- 4. Community Certificate in the case of BC/MBC/DNC/SC/ST and
- 5. Two copies of recent passport size photograph.

LIBRARY

NATIONAL CADET CORPS

SCHOLARSHIPS

Residential and Non-Residential scholarships are awarded to eligible students by the District Adi Dravidar Welfare Officer, Tirunelveli.

AD-HOC MERIT GRANT

Students who secure 60% and above in the Higher Secondary Examination are eligible for the above scholarship. Ad-Hoc Merit Grant is in addition to any other scholarship.

ADI DRAVIDAR WELFARE SCHOLARSHIP

Students residing in the college hostel or private recognised hostels alone are eligible for this scholarship. The loan scholarship may be availed in addition to any other scholarship.




